Everybody's Talking!

Grandpa makeover: A Chinese makeup artist has taken social media by storm with her extraordinary ability to transform her elderly grandfather into vibrant, anime-inspired figures. Using her impressive skills, she makes him appear decades younger, a feat that has amazed viewers online. Her side-by-side comparison videos amass millions of views and spark disbelief at the dramatic changes. This viral sensation has crossed borders, capturing interest in other parts of Asia and the West. The transformations highlight the artistry and potential of makeup, showcasing the artist's unique talent. She joins the ranks of other Chinese artists in redefining age through cosmetic wizardry.

Zebra chase: A zebra that had escaped and was spotted roaming the foothills of western Washington state (U.S.) was safely recaptured a week later. Despite her adventures in the wild, she appeared to be in good condition. The zebra was initially traveling with three other zebras in a trailer destined for the state of Montana, where they were going to be part of a petting zoo. While three of the animals were swiftly apprehended, the fourth zebra had managed to evade capture by hopping a fence and disappearing. Following numerous sightings, she was joyfully reunited with her dazzle, or group, of zebras.

Smart spoon: In Tokyo, Japan, Kirin Holdings has introduced the Elecspoon, a smart spoon designed to enhance the taste of low-sodium foods. Using electric current technology, this spoon tricks the taste buds into perceiving food as being saltier, which helps address Japan's common issue of excessive salt consumption. The Elecspoon generates an electric field that clusters sodium ions, enhancing the food's flavor. The device offers several intensity levels, powered by a rechargeable battery. Despite its benefits, it is unsuitable for people with facial nerve disorders or those undergoing dental treatments. Priced at ¥19,800 (JPY), the Elecspoon is available online and at select stores in Japan.

Muscle speech: Researchers in Los Angeles, California (U.S.), have developed a self-powered device that translates muscle movements into speech. This innovative patch adheres to the throat, using artificial intelligence to convert movements into spoken words. The lightweight device harnesses the energy from muscle movements to generate electricity, so it does not need a battery. Made of soft silicone, micromagnets, and copper wire coils, the patch creates electrical signals from the moving muscles. In tests, an algorithm accurately translated these signals into speech. This patch offers a promising solution for people with voice disorders.
